According to the Cabinet resolution on December 8, 2020, the country's reform plan for preventing and suppressing corruption and misconduct was approved. (Revised edition) with a drive to carry out important reform activities (Big Rock). Reform activity number 4: Develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and free of benefits. Goal No. 1, Section 1.1, "Have every government agency declare itself to be an agency where all government officials do not accept gifts and all kinds of gratuities in the performance of their duties (NO Gift Policy)".

In this regard, to drive forward the above national reform activities. Create transparency within the agency Create values in performing duties and should practice it as a culture of honesty Nong Phai Sun Subdistrict Administrative Organization Therefore, the policy has been announced to all executives, employees, officers, and personnel under the supervision. Do not accept gifts and gifts of any kind from the performance of duties (NO Gift Policy) on all festivals and special occasions. Except in cases of necessity and unavoidability, the rules for accepting gifts or gifts must be followed. and any other benefits in accordance with the regulations of the Office of the Prime Minister regarding giving or receiving gifts by government officials, B.E. 2001, together with the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the criteria for accepting property or any other benefits according to the ethics of government officials.
